#### **Update from the Barnes Farm PTA**

Our PTA have been working hard behind the scenes to get things up and running and we are immensely grateful for the time they have spent on this already for this academic year. Please see an update from Alex Dillon from the PTA below:

It has been a very busy term for the newly-reformed PTA, though we're acutely aware that it might not look like it from the outside!

We spent the summer trying to track down the various accounts and memberships that the PTA was part of, and begin the process of transferring them to the new team, including things like setting up the various websites, insurances and logistics we'll need, including DBS checks for the officers so that we can conduct activities on school premises.

As the PTA is a registered charity, there was quite a bottleneck of changes that could not be completed until the charity details were updated. Unfortunately, the Charity Commission decided to update and replace a lot of their systems over the summer, which really slowed down and complicated this process much more than we were anticipating. Once this was finally done, we could then transfer the bank details and remaining accounts into the names of the new trustees.

We've also been exploring possible future events and fundraising activities, now that we have everything in place to be able to run them, and we're working with both school heads to set up events for the rest of the school year. We look forward to being able to share more with you all soon.


