

The school, pupils and 3PR are trying to reduce the amount of traffic and congestion that often builds up outside of the schools during busy drop off and pick up times.

Henniker Gate is a narrow road on which the entrance of the school is situated. This road does not accommodate several vehicles approaching from both directions and can very easily become congested.

In addition, vehicles parked with wheels up on the pavement can create an obstruction and present a challenge for pedestrians, including children and buggies, trying to get past.

The schools and their pupils feel that something needs to be done and want to improve this situation, so they are asking for the full support of parents and carers to help improve the situation.

1 Care

- Be careful where you park
- Don't cause an obstruction
- Use a car park if available

2 Consideration

- Respect the school's parking policy
- Always consider the neighbours
- Don't block driveways
- Be polite and courteous
- If possible, walk or cycle instead

3 Caution

- Look out for other children, not just your own
- Always observe the speed limits
- Stay off the pavement

Here's how it works:



Above are some images of scenarios 3PR would like to highlight as areas to avoid.

The map above shows the 3PR parking zone in yellow.

Please avoid entering and parking in this zone.

Patrol Points are at each end of Henniker Gate and parking tokens can be collected from these points when the patrols are out.

A. Parking on the corners of junctions

It restricts the visibility for pedestrians crossing the road and the view of drivers entering and exiting the road

B. Parking on restrictions

Parking on double yellow lines, single yellow lines and school keep clear restricts is illegal

and you could receive a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN). Make sure you check the time restriction signs before leaving your vehicle.

C. Parking over the driveways of properties

This will cause inconvenience for the residents living in the property if they need to exit their driveway.

The schools have the benefit of being located in a residential area that has lots of roads accessible to the schools which are unrestricted (no yellow lines etc.)

We are creating a 3PR zone around Henniker Road and we will encourage parents and carers to avoid entering and parking in this zone.

We ask that parents and carers support this scheme by parking in the available space in the surrounding roads and walk the short distance with their child into the 3PR zone and the school.

The schools have arranged for a designated team of staff and pupils to patrol the 3PR zone. This team is known as 'The 3PR Patrol'.

The 3PR Patrol will be situated at both ends of the 3PR zone (marked 'Patrol Point' on the map). Any pupil who arrives at these points on foot, cycle or scooter will

be given a 3PR token to take into their classroom. The token can then be put into the class 3PR token box.



The tokens will then be counted at the end of each month and the class with the most tokens will be awarded the 3PR cup for that month. The class with the most tokens counted over the school year will become the 3PR Parking Champions.

This is a fun competition and we hope everyone will take

part. 3PR and the School Parking Initiative aims to encourage parents and carers, with encouragement from their children, to reconsider how and where they park; a few small changes in parking habits will make all the difference.



Remember! Always use the 3 parking rules ('care, caution and consideration') when parking.
