






Parents in Partnership - SIGN UP WITH YOUR INTEREST!

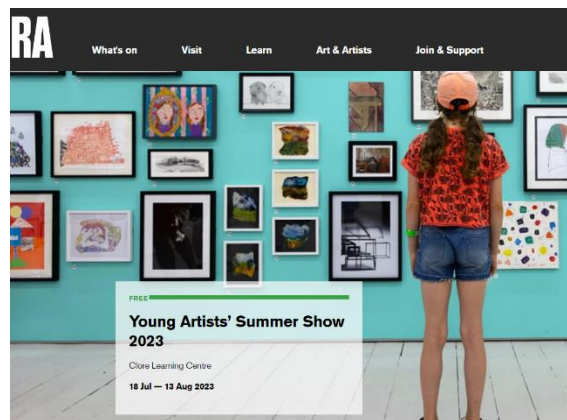

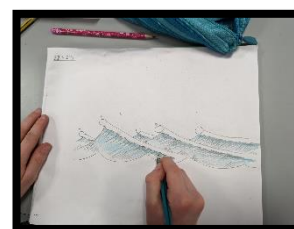
Have you got some amazing artwork you have created at home or at school?
