Home Learning Expectations



We are retaining the format for Home Learning that was established last year, and a separate, detailed letter has been emailed along with the newsletter this week. Teachers have been/will be explaining this as part of the Parent Information Meetings this week and next but you are always welcome to ask for clarification from your child's class teacher at any point. Please also give us feedback about

any aspect of home learning so we can add this to considerations for changes in the future.

Parent Information Meetings

As part of our commitment to sharing key information with you, we are hosting a parent information meeting for your child's year group (see dates below). This is a general meeting where the teachers will introduce the expectations for the year including home learning (spellings, maths etc), our Autumn term curriculum plus any other key information to share. There will be an opportunity to visit your child's classroom and ask any general questions around your child's first term too.



Individual parent consultations are scheduled for January 2020 and again in April 2020, where the class teacher will give you a detailed insight on your child's attainment and progress in key areas. Finally in the Summer term you will, of course, receive your child's full annual academic report.

There is no need to book for the Parent Information meeting and children are welcome to attend but this is not essential. Simply come along to the main school hall at the time listed below. If you are unable to make the time below, we will post information on our website which will provide of a summary of the key areas discussed.
