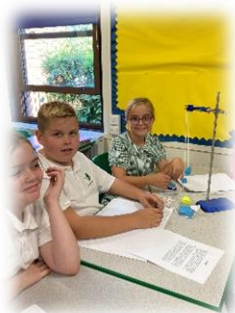

Year 3 have will be holding a general parent information meeting on Thursday 5th October at 5pm. This will be held in the Y3 classrooms in the Jubilee building.

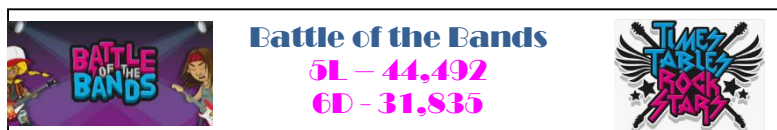


Thursday 5th October - Favourites Day
