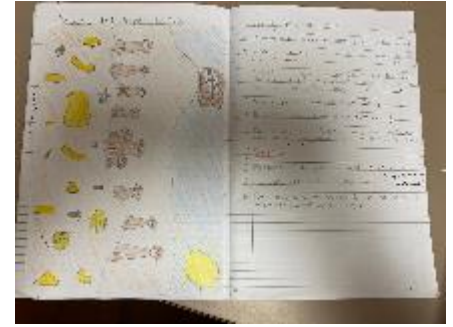

Creativity day

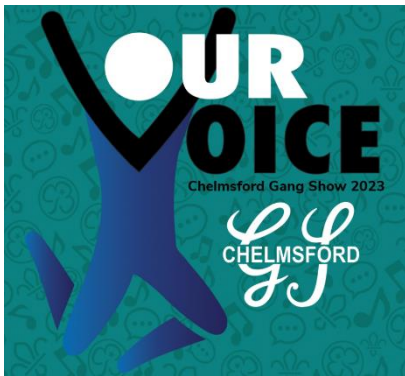
Today, children at Barnes Farm Junior School, have been showcasing their creativity to celebrate National Creativity Day along
