We were very pleased to note our most recent SATs results. They show an improving school overall. The children and staff worked extremely hard towards them and they represent the sum of 4 years' worth of investment. Reading results in particular, were extremely strong as were many of the higher level results. As with all schools, there are areas to still improve further and we will continue to focus on these over the coming months.

We have 10 pupils attending local Grammar schools which is significantly higher than in previous years.
