








Parents in Partnership - SIGN UP WITH YOUR INTEREST!

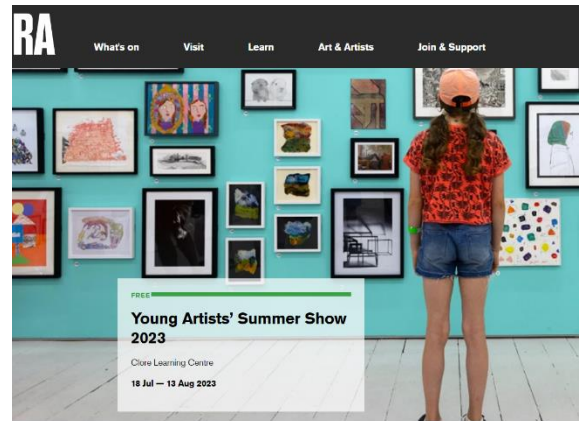
