Staffing Update

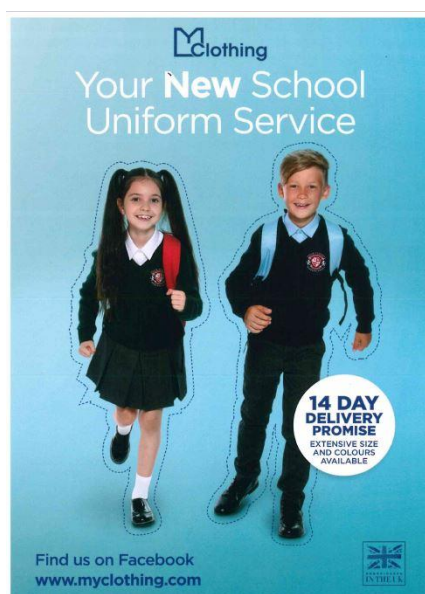
