Playground trials

Some of you will be aware from your children that we have piloted some different organisation of the playgrounds at lunchtimes in the last two weeks. This has been in order to provide a variety and richness of play opportunities that pupils have at this time, with suggestions made at Parent Voice in October being trialled. These include playing with children in the same house group, choosing particular playground environments (e.g. a 'run and fun' playground and a 'walk and talk' playground) and playing with children in other year groups they are not normally grouped with (e.g. Years 3 and 6 together). Additional play equipment has been bought and used this week and dates are confirmed for the replacement of other playground fixtures, such as the shade sails and the basketball hoops. We are working through the various combinations on one or two days per week and seeking feedback from children through class and school councils.
