


# E Safety Training

There is a complex web of reasons why children subject to online sexual exploitation will not disclose to us. This is as a result of grooming techniques used by pedophiles but more alarmingly is worsened by our current approach both as teachers and parents.

In 2014 John and John wrote, produced and presented 'The walk online' roadshow in Thurrock that was seen by over 5500 children. The roadshow was designed in a similar format to 'Too smart for Drugs' and was an outstanding success.

Throughout 2014 John and John were keynote speakers at a number of major events including the Essex Deputy Headteachers conference, the Essex Safeguarding Children's Board conference and the Rape Crisis conference
