Congratulations to our winning District Sports Team, who competed in field events on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> June and track events on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> June at Chelmsford Sports and Athletics Centre.

The team consisted of pupils from Years 3 to 6. Notable performances from Monday included Ore Kane, winner of the boys high jump and; Anton Aduwa Emovon winner of the boys long jump; Molly Tuff, winner of the girls throwing and Holly Rook, second place in the girls high jump.

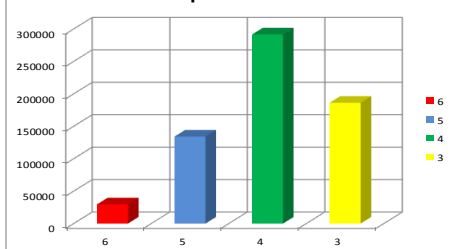
