Just like the teachers did, send us a picture of you 'caught doing some maths' in your everyday lives. The more imaginative the better!

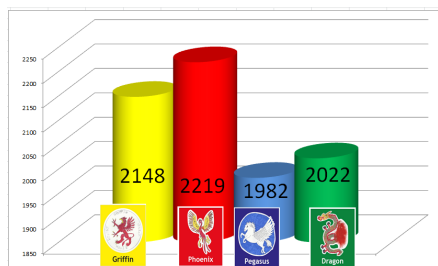



Christmas Jumper Day
