Harvest Festival Collection 2013

This harvest we're asking you to help feed local people in crisis by collecting tinned and dried food for Chelmsford foodbank. We are asking everyone to rally round to give items of tinned food (with the exception of soup). We will accept donations from Monday 30th Sept to Friday 18th October. Please send anything in that you can spare (and is in date!)

The foodbank provides short term emergency food to people in crisis. Food is given as an intervention strategy which allows care professionals, such as Church Pastoral Workers, Health Visitors, Social Services etc, time to put longer term measures in place. People are given enough food for 3 days.

Food is distributed at the foodbank centre based at the Waterfront Place, Wharf Road, Chelmsford. At the foodbank centre people also have access to information about other services and support organisations. It is open Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 10:00 to 12:30. All food given out by the foodbank is donated by generous members of the public.

We want to help our local foodbank feed people in need. Please join with us by giving food so that those less fortunate don't go hungry.


