Enrichment Donation

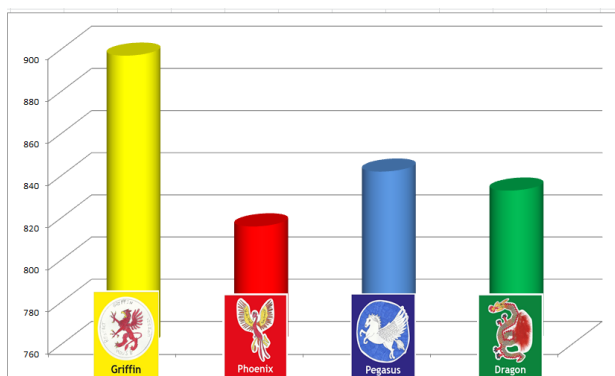
