## Learning Updates from around school

### Professional Development for the staff at BFJS

As well as the pupils, the staff at BFJS also develop their own learning so as to improve their provision even further. Below are some recent examples of how we support the professional development of the staff at school to benefit the children in our care.

#### AET Training Level 2 - Autism Awareness Training

The school hosted training on 27<sup>th</sup> November in the Barn for 7 of our own staff as well as staff from other local schools. The all-day session was led by a specialist teacher and further developed our understanding of how to better support our pupils on the autistic spectrum.

#### 'Pobble Presents' - BFJS hosts a regional teaching event



On 29<sup>th</sup> November we hosted a regional teaching event in our Barn which was attended by around 30 teachers interested in hearing from 5 different speakers. Topics discussed were raising standards in literacy, improving access to speech therapy and developing themed 'arts' days with greater parental involvement. The event attracted quite a following on Twitter - with the Government Department for Culture, Media and Sport even 'liking' a tweet about our school.

#### Creating Real Writers and Mathematicians

Miss Pyne and Miss Butterworth are attending this medium-term programme throughout the Autumn and Spring Term to explore fresh evidence-based approaches to raising standards in literacy and mathematics. This programme involves planning, teaching and observing lessons together as well as receiving specialist guidance from colleagues within the Chelmsford Teaching School Alliance.

#### Visual Impairment training

Two of our staff have attended this 2 day training to further develop our understanding of how pupils with a visual impairment need to be supported. The impact of this training will be not only to support individual pupils, but to also ensure that our school is as accessible for any member of our community with a visual impairment.

## FOBFS Winter Bazaar

Last Saturday saw both schools' halls and the Barn bustling with pupils, family and friends attending the Friends of Barnes Farm Schools PTA Winter Bazaar. Stalls selling food, gifts, bespoke artwork, toys and many more items were busy with happy customers and there were games, a tombola and a raffle to enter with many superb prizes on offer. The Barn was the venue for refreshments and gave tired feet the chance for a rest. Both schools' choirs participated and impressed the audience with their cheerful singing. At the time of writing, the estimated profit from the event is anticipated to be about £1000 - a fantastic amount!
