Morning Expectations

- Children are expected to walk from the Barn Playground to their classroom door (adjacent to the field) in the morning independently.

Personal Belongings

- All clothes should be clearly named.
- Children are expected to bring in a named water bottle that can be refilled throughout the day.
- Children need to bring in a **healthy snack** every day. This will go in a class snack box so children need to know what they've brought in.
- Children can bring in a named pencil case, however it is their responsibility. We do supply stationery for all children.

PE Lessons/Kit

- Year 3 PE lessons are on a Tuesday and are taught by SCS. Children must come in dressed in their PE kit. Long hair must be tied back and earrings taken out. They should be wearing a white t-shirt, black shorts and trainers.
- Every 4th Friday, Year 3 will have an additional afternoon of PE. Please see the weekly newsletter for these dates.

Learning Passports

- Children are expected to bring in their Learning Passport **every day**.
- Learning Passports are checked weekly to monitor the amount of reading completed at home. This contributes towards a class weekly reading percentage.

Home Learning Expectations

- Children are expected to read at least 5 times a week. This needs to be recorded in the Learning Passport. An adult needs to acknowledge this with a signature.
- On Friday, homework slips will be stuck into the Learning Passport. The children will need to complete their homework by the following week.
- A letter will be coming home shortly that will give details about the topic project homework that is set termly.

- Children will be led from the classroom to the Barn Playground at the end of the day.
